The annual Duck Race planning is about to begin! The club works hard every year to raise funds through the Duck Race, but where do they go?

This year, the club has already donated to the Northglenn and Thornton sock, food, and diaper drives, bought essentials to add to the gifts members purchased for CASA adolescents, supported the Northglenn Arts and Humanities Foundation, and more.

In the next few months, we'll award \$5,000 in scholarships to students in each of our four area school districts. We'll also provide a \$1,000 scholarship to Rotary District 5450 CU Global Health Program. April is our annual food drive month, so we'll be purchasing \$6,000 in food items to distribute to the local food banks using District matching grant funds.
